Eligible candidates may appear for Walk-in-Interview for the positions of one Research Associate, one Research Assistant, and Field Investigators on hired services in an ICSSR, Government of India sponsored project (F. No. 217/CRP-2023-379/JDY/SCD) titled '**Tribal Jan Dhan: An Assessment of the Impact of PMJDY on the Scheduled Tribes of West Bengal**' at the Department of Anthropology, University of Calcutta. Tenure

The position is likely to be available initially for three months (may be extended for five months) for the Research Associate and Research Assistant and a maximum of 90 days for Field Investigators. The posts will be terminated for the violation of research ethics. It is purely temporary and subject to the availability of funds of ICSSR, Government of India.

- 3. Field Investigator:** Postgraduate in any social science discipline with a minimum of 55% marks.

2. Experience in conducting household surveys and ethnographic fieldwork,
3. Preliminary knowledge of Scheduled Tribes (STs) of West Bengal

Job Description:

From time-to-time extensive traveling must be performed for the fieldwork of tribal communities across West Bengal. The Research Associate and Research Assistants may work independently in a team with Field Investigator(s). Day-to-day data collection, computational work, data monitoring, and preservation of fieldwork data are the key job of the Field Investigator. Contingent upon the nature of the job, candidates from the tribal-dominated districts will be preferred as Field Investigator, subject to the fulfillment of the essential qualification.
