- University degree in social work, social science, development studies or other relevant discipline, with 2-3 years demonstrated experience in a similar capacity
- Experience in working on health and community development projects, experience working with PRIs will be an added advantage
- Strong communication and networking skills, ability to work with people at all levels ranging from government officials, cluster GPs, etc.
- Skills in Community mobilization, Project Implementation, and Reporting of planned activities.
- Fluency in written and spoken Kannada and Basic Knowledge of English language is required.
- Good communication, leadership and facilitation skills.
- Willingness and ability to travel extensively in field areas of the project.
- Expertise in using MS office and web-based information systems.

#### **Roles and Responsibilities**

- Engaging and working closely with Gram Panchayats, Frontline Health Workers at the village level.
- Carry out data collection for research and routine program implementation.
- Mobilize and facilitate home based Family Focussed Communication sessions for the beneficiaries.
- Mobilize and facilitate the group sessions for the key stakeholders



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- Support and ensure Frontline Health Workers conduct ECCD activities.
- Participate in the monthly ASHA meeting/AWW meeting/GP level meeting to discuss the
