- 3. The cut-off date for determining the qualification and experience, age, etc. of candidate will be the date of Walk-in-interview.

- 7. The period of experience in a discipline / area of work, wherever prescribed, shall be counted after the date of acquiring the minimum prescribed essential educational qualifications for that position.

Candidates are required to come for Walk-in-interview with duly filled in application in prescribed format along with a recent passport size photograph, and bring all certificates / testimonials, in original and a set of self-attested photocopies of the same, in support of age, qualification and experience for verification. Incomplete application in any form will be rejected.
- 9. No TA/boarding/lodging will be admissible to the candidates appearing for the interview.
