Broad area of Research: Protein Biochemistry and Biophysical chemistry

Project Details:
i) This project will involve expression & purification of recombinant proteins and their biophysical characterization.
ii) To test efficacy of small molecules in inhibiting cataract onset using *in vitro* experiments, cell culture and animal model-based experiments.
iii) Synthesis and characterization of small molecules.

Duration of the project: 3 years. (The appointment will be renewed every year based on satisfactory performance).

Fellowship Amount (Rs.): Rs. 37,000.00 per month

Accommodation: Hostel accommodation will be provided subjected to availability and will be governed by the rules and regulations of the institute prevailing at the time of joining of the candidate.

Qualification: Candidates with M.Sc. (Chemistry or Biotechnology or Life Sciences) or M.Tech. (Biotechnology) having NET or GATE or any other national level examination conducted by central government departments or their agencies like DST, DBT, ICAR, ICMR, DRDO, etc. may apply.
