As per the Government Order No.DPAR 19 SBC 89, dated 12.07.1989, the vacancy earmarked in the backlog for Scheduled Caste shall be filled up by Scheduled Tribe and vice-versa, if suitable candidates belonging to the category for which the vacancy is reserved are not available.

QUALIFICATIONS

TEACHING POSTS:

1) Professor Cadre:

- 1 An eminent scholar having a Ph. D degree in the concerned/ related discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work, with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer reviewed/ NAAS / UGC listed journals.
- 2 A minimum of ten years of teaching Service in university as Assistant Professor / Associate Professor and / or research / extension experience at equivalent level, out of which 2 years of service/experience in the cadre of Associate Professor (Pre revised scale Rs.37400-67000 +9000 AGP or equivalent to new scale) shall be mandatory.

2) Associate Professor Cadre:

- 1 A Good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/related disciplines.
- 2 A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (For Traditional System) or 2.5 out of 4.00(For Trimester System) or 7.00 out of 10.00 (For Semester System).
- 3 A minimum of eight years of regular service of Teaching/Research/Extension in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Research Institutions Recognized by Central / State Govts. and a minimum of 07 publications in the peer-reviewed or NAAS rated or UGC-listed journals.
- 4 Significant contribution to Teaching/ Research/Extension with minimum score as stipulated in the prescribed Score-card.

Note:

1. The candidates applying for the posts in the cadre of **Professor & Associate Professor** have to enclose their bio-data and reprints of publications.
2. The time taken by candidates to acquire M. Phil. and / or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.

3) Assistant Professor Cadre:

1. A Master's degree with at least 55% (For traditional System) or 60% (For Trimester System) or 70% (For Semester System) marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
2. Besides fulfilling the above mentioned qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/ICAR/CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M. Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Guidelines, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.
Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009 shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Guidelines of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in the Universities subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- (a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- (b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;

- (c) The Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate should have been conducted;
- (d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- (e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICAR/ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

Note: *The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean of the University concerned.*

Note: NET shall not be required for such Master's Programmes in disciplines for which NET is not conducted by the UGC, ICAR, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

Note:

1. Detailed qualifications for concerned subjects are prescribed separately for each discipline.
2. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy Layer)/Differently abled/ Specially abled(a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks(For Traditional System) or 60% marks(For Trimester System) or 70% marks (For Semester System) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.

GENERAL: Candidates with knowledge of Kannada are preferred for the teaching posts in the University.

INSTRUCTIONS

2. The candidates applying for the posts have to enclose application processing fee in the form of **Indian Postal Order / Demand Draft for Rs. 500/- payable to the "Comptroller, UAS, Dharwad"** drawn within the period from **29.06.2024 to 29.07.2024** while submitting the filled in application pro-forma.
3. **The filled-in applications which do not accompany the prescribed processing fee are liable to be rejected.**
4. Separate applications with separate fee are required for each of the post applied. Application for two different posts should not be tagged together.
5. The procedure for selection of candidates for the posts shall be in accordance with the Karnataka Civil Services (Unfilled vacancies reserved for the persons belonging to Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes) (Special Recruitment) Rules, 2001, notified by GOK vide No.DPAR 13 SBC 2001, dated 21.11.2001 and 1.6.2002.

11. Applications must be accompanied by attested copies of Marks Sheets, Certificates, Experience Certificates, Publications, Research Notes, Certificates of Awards/Medals, Certificates related to past service etc. and the details of research or related publication, in any, in support of eligibility.
12. No applicant for any post shall be eligible for appointment if he/she is, at the time of his/her application, is in permanent employment in any other Department of Government or any other State Government or Central Government or Quasi Government or any other University and has made the applications without the consent of the Head of the Department or of the Government or Head of the University, as the case may be, under whom he/she is employed. Accordingly, candidates already in service (Government/Quasi Government or private) should submit their applications through their Controlling Officers as indicated supra. Candidates anticipating delay in sending their applications through proper channel, may submit an advance copy of the application within the prescribed last date along with the processing fee. B. Professor of Agricultural Economics:

- i. An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in **Agricultural Economics** and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work, with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer reviewed/ NAAS / UGC listed journals.
- ii. A minimum of ten years of teaching Service in university as Assistant Professor / Associate Professor and / or research / extension experience at equivalent level, out of which 2 years of service/experience in the cadre of Associate Professor (Pre revised scale Rs.37400-67000 +9000 AGP or equivalent to new scale) shall be mandatory.
